Pre-Care

For clients prone to PIH or with melanin-rich skin, begin a tyrosinase inhibitor several weeks prior to support outcomes. Discontinue exfoliating actives 7 days prior to treatment.

PROTOCOL

CLEANSE + PREP

Prepare skin by cleansing with Dermethod Morning Touch Cleanser as a pre-cleanse (optional) and Dermethod Revive Cleansing Gel.

TREATMENT STEPS

1. Apply Dermethod Priming Peel Booster Pad (Optional).
2. Without rinsing, proceed by stamping the skin with Dermethod's Mela Effector ampoule. 1 to 3 passes is recommended.
3. Apply Triple Revive Action Sheet Mask for 10-15 minutes. Use Twin Cooler over sheet mask for cryotherapy (optional).

FINISHING STEPS

Apply Ami-Sterol Cream and SPF of choice.
